


Fall Discipleship Begins

ARE YOU GROWING AS A DISCIPLE OF JESUS CHRIST?

On May 2, 2012 at the quarterly business meeting our church approved the adoption of the new Constitution, Bylaws, and Operations and Procedures manual for TBC. With the new documents in effect we now have one annual member's meeting instead of quarterly business meetings. requests for scholarships and adoption assistance, approving a donation to the Casa De Mi Padre Orphanage in Guatemala, receiving monthly reports from the finance committee, personnel committee, buildings and grounds committee, the deacon body, and the pastoral staff, carefully considering and approving the iXL Academy After School Program and hiring Marilynn Wright as the director of the program.

The iXL Academy After School Program was recommended by the preschool committee as a way to help students and parents, because the public school cancelled their after school program. It is also a good way to prepare the church for the possibility of opening a preschool for the 2013-14 school year. As of now we have 14 students enrolled in iXL which began on August 16, 2012. Registration and enrollment will remain open for the duration of the program.

In addition, the deacons are in the process of training new deacon candidates. There will be a six week training session that begins on Sunday, September 9. In addition to the new deacon candidates, all current deacons are invited to be a part of the training process as well. New deacons will be presented to the church for approval at the annual member's meeting.
