

The Road To Discipleship






DISCIPLESHIP CLASSES

True joy and Christ's love begin to live within them, giving them a life of purpose. What does it mean to be a mature Christian? Why does Paul say, "To live is Christ but to die is gain"? Dig deeper into the book of Philippians with Matt Chandler, Pastor of the Village Church in Dallas, TX.

Faithful, Abundant, True: Join Beth Moore, Kay Arthur, And Priscilla Shirer for a seven-session women's Bible study. Study the rich teachings of scripture with three ladies who are going deeper still. Kay challenges ladies to faithfulness in difficult days. Priscilla points to the essential of trust in God's ability, and Beth teaches on how to discern truth from error.







Discipleship Classes



What does it mean to be a disciple? What does a true disciple look like? This study lays a foundation to help believers strengthen their relationship with Christ.


